1. Using Chrome, login in to e-CLASSES at <https://eclasses.contactnorth.ca/>

Ensure your headset (recommended) or microphone & speaker; webcam are plugged in






3. When AppSetup.exe is done installing, click on **Install Saba Meeting Chrome Connector**.




4. A new tab will open, click on **+ Add to Chrome**.




5. In the pop-up window **click on *Add extension***.




6. Return to the first tab and **click on *Launch client***.



7. Saba Meeting will now launch and load your session.



8. Once in your session, click the **Adjust audio** button to test your audio and adjust volumes:



- **Test your speaker or headset:** click the green **Play** button to ensure you can hear the audio clip; adjust volumes as needed.
- **Test your microphone:** speak into your microphone to ensure that the green volume bar changes levels as you speak. Click to set the volume level.
